# Curing and Healing

**Curing** is an action carried out by a healthcare practitioner to eradicate a disease or correct a problem. (Cassell)

**Healing** is a process leading to a greater sense of integrity or wholeness in response to injury or disease that occurs within the patient, which can be facilitated by the healthcare practitioner. (Mount and Kearney)






### Healing







# An Important Tension in Complex Systems

#### Intention and Emergence

## Relationships

In complex systems, relationships are key. Connections or relationships define how complex systems work.

Surprisingly simple rules for relationships in a very complex system:
Starling flocks

- Maintain a minimum distance from other birds and objects (such as windows)
- Maintain the same speed as neighbouring birds (measured in three dimensions around the bird)
- Head towards the centre of the flock.
